So this note is not a so much a "Steward's Soapbox", as it is a short "Steward's Congratulations and Invitation". A congratulations to all of you who made it to the first championship race of the year - job well done, and an invitation to everyone who has yet to attend their first 2006 race. We're looking forward to all of you racing safely and competitively, enjoying the fruits of your labor.

For those who attended the first race, thanks for being
there. Ron and I hope you had a fun and safe event. I guess the "Penalty Box" in the next Memo will show how attentive and conservative you were!

Before we see the next Memo, there will have been four championship events. Everyone will be doing their best to do their best. Related to Pres. Linda Heinrich's column last month, Conference is, and has always been, the race place where you get the most bang for your buck - both in good, clean, close racing and the camaraderie of fine competitors. We know the cost of racing continues to rise. But there are ways we can control some direct and indirect racing costs when we're on the race track - other than not buying those new tires.

## SCCBC Event Supplementary Regulations 2006

Your application/entry to the event constitutes acceptance of these Supplementary Regulations. Infractions will result in penalties being assessed to the driver.

1. All events are to be held on the Mission Raceway Park road course in a counter clockwise direction.
2. All events will be timed \& scored by the AMB Transponder System. Race cars must have a suitable transponder installed and operating in each session.
3. Open to cars eligible under ASN Canada FIA, CACC, SCCA or ICSCC current regulations.
4. Insurance shall be as per ASN Canada FIA and CACC regulations or ICSCC as applicable.
5. All competitors, entrants, crewmembers and guests must sign the official release agreement and waiver.
6. All minors (under 19) require a signed "minor waiver" for each event (available at Registration).
7. Minors (16 and over) are allowed to be in hot pits provided a parent/legal guardian has signed the appropriate minor waiver.
8. NSF cheques will be charged an additional $\$ 25.00$ Canadian fee.
9. Competitors affected by a race cancellation will be notified by telephone, if possible, or by first class letter.
10. Consumption of alcohol during an event is NOT PERMITTED at Mission Raceway Park! You are responsible for the behavior of your crew and guests.
11. Registration \& Tech hours and procedures for handling Late Entries as per the race announcement.
12. Driver Services and the Official Notice Board are located in the SCCBC Clubhouse near Pregrid.
13. Novice/License Director will be located just west of the entrance to pit lane.(ICSCC-Pit 1/ CACC-Pit 77)
14. No racing engines may be started prior to $8: 50 \mathrm{am}$. Warm as quietly as possible until 9:00am.
15. The scales will be open Saturday from noon and Sunday all day.
16. No skateboards, scooters, or roller blades. Bicycles and small motorized vehicles allowed by permission of the Race Chairmen only. Permission may be withdrawn at any time. NO ONE UNDER 16 IS ALLOWED TO OPERATE A MOTORIZED VEHICLE!
17. Both front paved lanes in the Paddock area run EASTBOUND after 8:50am. Rear lane is two way. Speed Limit: SLOW - excessive speed will be subject to penalties assessed by the Race Chairmen.
18. Refueling not allowed in Pregrid. Fueling in the Hot Pits requires a crewmember assigned only to manning a fire bottle.
19. NO SMOKING allowed in Hot Pits, Pregrid, or any Mission Raceway Park Building, no animals allowed in Hot Pits or Pregrid.
20. The Hot Pit speed limit is Fifty (50) Kilometers per hour ( 30 mph ). The Hot Pit Lane ends at the Starters Tower.
21. Only ONE support vehicle allowed in Paddock/Pit area. Roads MUST remain clear. All Support vehicles and trailers must be parked perpendicular to the track unless permission is obtained in writing from the organizer.
22. No race vehicle may exceed 95decibels ( db ) measured at 50 ft . from the racing surface. Readings will be taken at an acceleration point Cars exceeding the db limit will have one or more of their Qualifying times in that session erased, or be disqualified from their race.
23. Damage to track, grounds, buildings or equipment, regardless of cause, will be charged to the driver responsible. Damage to paved areas may result in fines. You are required to protect the asphalt from damage by jacks, jack stands, poles, etc.
24. If entries exceed the number of cars allowed on the track (determined by the Race Chairmen) for a particular group, drivers and cars entered, as an "additional entry" will be restricted from participating, based on the date the entries were received. This is in order to allow participation by those for whom the event is their primary event, including novices upgrading to a championship event.
25. All entries for this event shall present, at tech inspection, empty sealable container(s) marked with the driver's name and number, capable of holding 8L. (2 gal.) of liquids. These are to be used to hold all oil, cleaners, brake fluid, etc. There are recycling containers for these fluids along the back road of the paddock near the garbage cans.
26. All hazardous waste spills are to be reported to the Race Chairman. Anyone caught dumping oil will be FINED and BANNED from the raceway. There are recycling containers for these fluids along the back road of the paddock near the garbage cans.
27. DO NOT BLOCK THE PAVED PADDOCK LANES DURING RACES. Trailers may be loaded at the back of the paddock.
28. Tire scrubbing is not allowed at any time during practice or qualifying sessions. Scrubbing is allowed only on the pace laps preceding the initial green flag starting a race, or under pace car control.
29. The importation and use of leaded fuels for use in motor vehicles is permitted in Canada only for use in racing vehicles. Leaded fuel is not available for sale at gas stations in Canada.
30. No open fires anywhere! Barbecues will be the only exception as long as they are away from any combustible source such as gas cans, gas tanks or fuel cells, etc.
31. No overnight camping at the track Sunday night without permission, please contact the SCCBC President.
32. Gates are locked for the evening at $\mathbf{1 0 : 3 0} \mathbf{p m}$ and reopened at 7:00am. In case of emergency please call the emergency access number posted on the inside of the front gate. There is a pay phone at the far east end of the spectator parking lot.
33. Long pants, sleeved shirts, closed toe shoes, and visible wristbands are to be worn in the Pregrid, Hot Pits and Impound areas.
34. Cars arriving at Pregrid after the 5-minute warning will be put at the back of the grid
35. All pets must be on a reasonable length leash while on site.
36. Late Registrations on Sunday MAY be accepted, at the Race Chairmen's discretion.
37. BLEND LINE. On entering the track, keep four (4) wheels to the right of the solid line, two (2) wheels to the right of the dash line.
38. Entrants in the Solo 1 group must comply with all sections of the 2006 CACC Solo Events Rules, Section 4, pertaining to Hillclimbs

## NorthWest Motor Sports SUN N' FUN Grand Prix Supplemental Regulations (Special Stuff at Spokane)

1. Passes are required at all times and must be displayed.
2. See race announcement for registration and tech hours.
3. NSF checks will be charged and additional $\$ 50.00$ fee.
4. Functioning AMB transponders are required for this event.
5. Trick racing fuel will be available at SRP for purchase.
6. Vendors wishing to sell fuel will be charged a $\$ 150.00$ fee payable to Spokane Raceway Park.
7. Tire services MAY be available.
8. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed only after the racetrack closes for the day. Anyone caught consuming or under the influence of alcohol prior to track closure will be asked to leave. See ICSCC rule \#610-impairment. This rule will be enforced by the race steward.
9. No smoking is allowed hot pits, Pre-grid or any SRP buildings.
10. No open fires! BBQ's may be used on pavement or gravel areas only.
11. Minor release forms must be completed by parent/guardian for all minors under the age of 18 .
12. Children under 16 years of age are not allowed in hot pits or pre-grid. Children under 12 years of age must have direct supervision at all times.
13. Pets must be on leashes at all times.
14. No skateboards or roller blades. Bicycles and small motorized vehicles may be operated in the paved/gravel areas of the paddock.
15. Pit and pre-grid roads must remain clear. This is a fire department requirement.
16. Speed limit in paddock is SLOW!! Please use extreme caution. The race chairman will strictly enforce this regulation.
17. No racing engines may be started prior to $7: 15 \mathrm{am}$. Due to sound ordinance all racing engines must be shut down after 9:00 pm on each day.
18. Refueling is not allowed in pre-grid.
19. ICSCC rule \#1112-Noise, enforced! 103db at 50 feet from the edge of the track. No exceptions. You will be black flagged for noise.
20. Family and crew members of drivers are to contact the communication person at pre-grid with any questions regarding their car or driver.
21. Damage to the track, ground or buildings, regardless of cause will be charged to the driver responsible. Also, any damage to any equipment or devices utilized by ICSCC or NWMS to conduct this race will be charged to the responsible driver.
22. Because of the possibility of hot weather at Spokane Raceway, damage to the asphalt paving in the paddock, pre-grid or any of the SRP road surfaces may result from the use of jack stands, floor jacks, canopy poles, etc. Please bring something to use under these items.
23. All entrants at this event must be prepared to present at tech inspection an empty, re-sealable container(s), marked with the drivers name and license number, capable of holding 2 gallons of liquids. These are to be used to remove all antifreeze, brake fluid, cleaners etc. from Spokane raceway.
24. Anyone caught dumping oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission oil, solvents etc. in either garbage cans or on the ground will be fined and banned from the raceway. This is a Spokane Raceway regulation and is strictly enforced.
25. No tires will be disposed of or abandoned at Spokane Raceway.
26. Be prepared for warm weather. Drink plenty of fluids!!
27. All withdrawals must be submitted in writing to registration prior to the time on-track sessions begin for the Saturday or Sunday race group(s) from which the entry is being withdrawn. Withdrawal forms will be available in Registration.
28. No parking in roped off area reserved for Saturday night drag races without the approval of the Race Chairman. Ample paddock space will be available without relocation. Cooperation with the Paddock Marshal upon arrival is required if you wish to have a permanent spot for the weekend.
29. All cars must exit at turn 4 after all practice, qualifying and race sessions.
30. Any car exiting at turn 4 and proceeding to the pits may not re-enter the race session. (Race only).
31. PLEASE - all cars required to have tow rings - PLEASE, PLEASE have them / it is very difficult to get cars out of the pea gravel without them.

Any Additions or changes to these Supplemental Regulations will be in the form of a Driver Letter in the Driver packet you receive at Registration. You, the driver, are responsible for reading these regulations and ensuring that you, your crew members and family understand and follow them. The Driver is responsible for any infractions.
