## I.R.D.C. EVENT SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS

1. Open to cars eligible under I.C.S.C.C. and S.C.C.A. current regulations.
2. There will be no starting of any race engines prior to 9:00 a.m.
3. No class changes after 1:00 p.m. on Saturday.
4. Drivers are responsible for properly and completely filling out their entry registration form(s).
5. Multiple Entries: A driver entering the same car in more than one event shall indicate on each entry form whether the entry is for the driver's "primary" or "additional" event. If the entries are oversubscribed for a particular event (entries exceed the number of cars allowed on the track) drivers and cars entered as an "additional" event will be restricted from participating, on a first come, first served priority based on the date the entries are received, in order to allow participation by all drivers and cars for whom the event is their primary event including novices upgrading to a championship event on that week-end.
6. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is **NOT** allowed at any time during the racing event, except in the area covered by the liquor permit issued by the Washington State Liquor Control Board. The time and location is a condition of operation of the track and is enforced by track officials, ICSCC, and IRDC officials or law enforcement authorities.
7. All Entrants shall present at tech inspection empty, seal-able, container(s) marked with driver's name and car number, capable of holding 2 gallons of liquids. These are to be used to remove all oil, cleaners, brake fluid, etc. from P.R. Anyone caught dumping oil at the raceway will be fined and banned from Pacific Raceway. There will be a \$10.00 per tire charge imposed by the track for the disposal of tires.
8. Damage to the track, grounds or buildings, regardless of cause, will be charged to the driver responsible. Any damage to any equipment or devices utilized by the sanctioning body (ICSCC) or sponsoring club (IRDC) to conduct this race, regardless of cause, will be charged to the driver responsible.
9. NOISE RULE I.C.S.C.C. 1112 enforced! 103db @ 50 ft. No exceptions.
10. All persons in pre-grid or in racing hot pits shall wear long pants, shirts that cover their shoulders and no open-toed shoes during all practices, qualifying and races.
11. A Minor Release form is required for **ALL** minors upon entry to the track (NO EXCEPTIONS). Minors must be under direct supervision of an adult at all times. No minors under 18 years of age are allowed in the hot pits or pre-grid. Operation of any type of wheeled transportation (bikes, scooters, motorcycles, skateboards, skates, etc.) is forbidden for anyone under the age of 16 years.
12. All cars will be off trailers for tech inspection.
13. There will be no refunds on prepaid pit passes.
14. Driver must appear in person at registration to add a crew member to the list on their registration form.
15. All participants are required to have and display at all times the appropriate pit, crew, guest, or worker pass issued for this event. Passes are required for reentry to Pacific Raceway during this event.
16. No overnight camping at the track on Sunday night without the consent of P.R. management.
17. There will be no refueling in the grid area unless accompanied by a fire extinguisher and operator.
18. No motorized tow or support vehicles allowed on pre-grid unless authorized by the Grid Marshall or Race Chairman. Support vehicles behind pre-grid must be parked along the fence
19. No open fires are allowed in the paddock, pre-grid or within the track in-field.
20. All gates are locked at 11:00 PM Friday and Saturday nights. The main gate will open at 7:00 AM.
21. Only one support vehicle or trailer is allowed in the pits per competition car.
22. There will be no saving of pit or paddock areas except as required by I.C.S.C.C. regulations with exception of Novice License director or by Race Chairman for cause. All other pit and paddock areas are on a first come, first served basis. Violators of this regulation can be subject to disqualification.
23. The length of scheduled events may be altered by the Race Chairman due to emergency conditions beyond the control of I.R.D.C. personnel.
24. I.R.D.C. reserves the right to refuse entry to this event to anyone.
25. Line formation to enter the track on Friday afternoon shall start at the main registration booth. The waiver sheet must be signed prior to entry into the pits on Friday.
26. No bicycles, scooters, or walking allowed on the access road adjacent to the main straight from the paddock to pre-grid. This is a P.R. rule.
27. **King County bicycle helmet laws are enforced at P.R.** – anyone operating a bicycle or scooter is required to wear a helmet. No motor vehicles allowed in the infield except for race workers.
28. Pets must be leashed at all times and owners are responsible for cleaning up animal waste.
29. All in-car timing system transmitter beacons will be placed at a marked location as defined by the Race Chairman. All transmitters outside of the specified area will be confiscated and retained by the Race Chairman.
30. Turn 1 / Pit Out blend line violators will be dealt with by the Race Steward.

## SCCBC Event Supplementary Regulations 2006

Your application/entry to the event constitutes acceptance of these Supplementary Regulations. Infractions will result in penalties being assessed to the driver.

1. All events are to be held on the Mission Raceway Park road course in a counter clockwise direction.
2. All events will be timed & scored by the AMB Transponder System. Race cars must have a suitable transponder installed and operating in each session.
3. Open to cars eligible under ASN Canada FIA, CACC, SCCA or ICSCC current regulations.
4. Insurance shall be as per ASN Canada FIA and CACC regulations or ICSCC as applicable.
5. All competitors, entrants, crewmembers and guests must sign the official release agreement and waiver.
6. All minors (under 19) require a signed "minor waiver" for each event (available at Registration).
7. Minors (16 and over) are allowed to be in hot pits **provided** a parent/legal guardian has signed the appropriate minor waiver.
8. NSF cheques will be charged an additional \$25.00 Canadian fee.
9. Competitors affected by a race cancellation will be notified by telephone, if possible, or by first class letter.
10. **Consumption of alcohol during an event is NOT PERMITTED at Mission Raceway Park! You are responsible for the behavior of your crew and guests.**
11. Registration & Tech hours and procedures for handling Late Entries as per the race announcement.
12. Driver Services and the Official Notice Board are located in the SCCBC Clubhouse near Pregrid.
13. Novice/License Director will be located just west of the entrance to pit lane.(ICSCC-Pit 1/ CACC-Pit 77)
14. No racing engines may be started prior to 8:50am. Warm as quietly as possible until 9:00am.
15. The scales will be open Saturday from noon and Sunday all day.
16. No skateboards, scooters, or roller blades. Bicycles and small motorized vehicles allowed by permission of the Race Chairmen only. Permission may be withdrawn at any time. **NO ONE UNDER 16 IS ALLOWED TO OPERATE A MOTORIZED VEHICLE!**
17. Both front paved lanes in the Paddock area run EASTBOUND after 8:50am. Rear lane is two way. Speed Limit: SLOW - excessive speed will be subject to penalties assessed by the Race Chairmen.
18. Refueling not allowed in Pregrid. Fueling in the Hot Pits requires a crewmember assigned only to manning a fire bottle.
19. NO SMOKING allowed in Hot Pits, Pregrid, or any Mission Raceway Park Building, no animals allowed in Hot Pits or Pregrid.
20. The Hot Pit speed limit is Fifty (50) Kilometers per hour (30 mph). The Hot Pit Lane ends at the Starters Tower.
21. Only ONE support vehicle allowed in Paddock/Pit area. Roads **MUST** remain clear. All Support vehicles and trailers must be parked perpendicular to the track unless permission is obtained in writing from the organizer.
22. No race vehicle may exceed 95decibels (db) measured at 50ft. from the racing surface. Readings will be taken at an acceleration point. Cars exceeding the db limit will have one or more of their Qualifying times in that session erased, or be *disqualified* from their race.
23. Damage to track, grounds, buildings or equipment, regardless of cause, will be charged to the driver responsible. Damage to paved areas may result in fines. You are required to protect the asphalt from damage by jacks, jack stands, poles, etc.
24. If entries exceed the number of cars allowed on the track (determined by the Race Chairmen) for a particular group, drivers and cars entered, as an "additional entry" will be restricted from participating, based on the date the entries were received. This is in order to allow participation by those for whom the event is their primary event, including novices upgrading to a championship event.
25. All entries for this event shall present, at tech inspection, empty sealable container(s) marked with the driver's name and number, capable of holding 8L. (2 gal.) of liquids. These are to be used to hold all oil, cleaners, brake fluid, etc. There are recycling containers for these fluids along the back road of the paddock near the garbage cans.
26. All hazardous waste spills are to be reported to the Race Chairman. Anyone caught dumping oil will be FINED and BANNED from the raceway. There are recycling containers for these fluids along the back road of the paddock near the garbage cans.
27. **DO NOT BLOCK THE PAVED PADDOCK LANES DURING RACES.** Trailers may be loaded at the back of the paddock.
28. **Tire scrubbing is not allowed at any time during practice or qualifying sessions.** Scrubbing is allowed only on the pace laps preceding the initial green flag starting a race, or under pace car control.
29. The importation and use of leaded fuels for use in motor vehicles is permitted in Canada only for use in racing vehicles. Leaded fuel is not available for sale at gas stations in Canada.
30. No open fires anywhere! Barbecues will be the only exception as long as they are away from any combustible source such as gas cans, gas tanks or fuel cells, etc.
31. No overnight camping at the track Sunday night without permission, please contact the SCCBC President.
32. **Gates are locked for the evening at 10:30pm and reopened at 7:00am.** In case of emergency please call the emergency access number posted on the inside of the front gate. There is a pay phone at the far east end of the spectator parking lot.
33. Long pants, sleeved shirts, closed toe shoes, and visible wristbands are to be worn in the Pregrid, Hot Pits and Impound areas.
34. Cars arriving at Pregrid after the 5-minute warning will be put at the back of the grid
35. All pets must be on a reasonable length leash while on site.
36. Late Registrations on Sunday MAY be accepted, at the Race Chairmen's discretion.
37. **BLEND LINE.** On entering the track, keep **four (4) wheels** to the right of the solid line, **two (2) wheels** to the right of the dash line.
38. Entrants in the Solo 1 group must comply with all sections of the 2006 CACC Solo Events Rules, Section 4, pertaining to Hillclimbs

# Steward's Soapbox

Congratulations everyone. You've done a great job heeding our warnings about passing during yellow flag situations. You're making the races and the environments for the turn workers who help you, much safer. Keep seeing the turn stations and keep up the good work.

With three races in the books and a lot of season ahead of us, maybe it's a good time to cover a short list of subjects for the upcoming races. Here's a thought: unless you drove off the track all by yourself and ran into something, or smacked your car with a wrench, body damage on your racer was probably caused by on-track contact with another car. With that in mind, here are some quick advisories on how to avoid body damage and prevent those awkward post-race conversations with your competitors and the Steward.

**Advisory Number 1: WATCH YOUR MIRRORS.** No rocket science involved here. If you pay attention to who is around you (or coming up fast), you can plan ahead. You'll be able to position your car so you remain competitive, yet not be a moving chicane for faster cars.

Is it *really* necessary to put you and your car at 11/10ths turn after turn, to keep a faster car in another class from passing you – especially when you're not racing for position in your own class? The answer is "no". **Advisory Number 2: BE CONSCIENTIOUS.** You've got lots of common sense. Use it to keep you and your fellow racers out of harm's way.

In most groups, many cars have very similar lap times even though they may run in different classes. And many classes enjoy very tight competition. **Advisory Number 3: IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO GIVE RACING**

ROOM. Again, not rocket science. You are certainly not obligated to slow down and move way off line just because someone is close to you. But you do have the responsibility to leave enough room on the racing surface so your fellow racers can keep all four wheels on the track if they're along side you. You don't want to be crowded off the track, nor does anyone else.

You want the win and you *really* want to make that pass. Or maybe you've come upon a slower car and they're delaying your progress. A fender-nurf. A bumper-shove. You try to put a whole car where only one-third of one will fit. You do the ultra late-brake maneuver with no hope of making the corner without the assistance of whoever you hit. **Advisory number 4: OVER-AGGRESSIVE DRIVING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.** In addition to all the negative effects this kind of racing has on race budgets, event schedules, and deterring new racers from joining us, it's a huge safety issue. Do you really want to be the one who causes the write off of a race car, and maybe worse – all for the opportunity to put a \$10 trophy in a box in your basement?

OK, that's it for my advisories. Please take them to heart – and to the races for the remainder of the season. You are a great group of skilled racers. Do your part to eliminate those awkward conversations and remember that Conference doesn't have Competition Suggestions. It has Competition Regulations. Ron and I will do all we can to help you have the safest, most fun and best competition available.

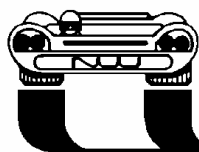

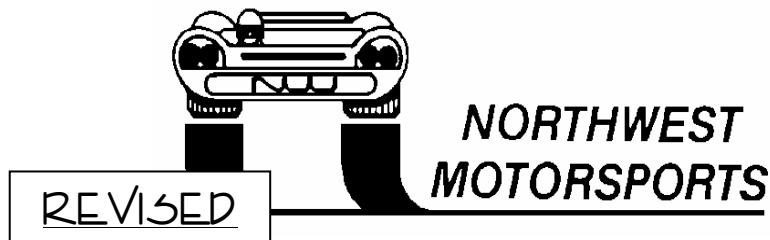

1. Passes are required at all times and must be displayed.
2. See race announcement for registration and tech hours.
3. NSF checks will be charged and additional \$50.00 fee.
4. Functioning AMB transponders are required for this event.
5. Tire services **MAY** be available.
6. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed only after the conclusion of ICSCC racing for the day. Anyone caught consuming or under the influence of alcohol prior to track closure will be asked to leave. See ICSCC rule #610-impairment. This rule will be enforced by the race steward.
7. No smoking is allowed hot pits, Pre-grid or any SRP buildings.
8. No open fires! BBQ's may be used on pavement or gravel areas only.
9. Minor release forms must be completed by parent/guardian for all minors under the age of 18.
10. Children under 16 years of age are not allowed in hot pits or pre-grid. Children under 12 years of age must have direct supervision at all times.
11. Pets must be on leashes at all times.
12. No skateboards or roller blades. Bicycles and small motorized vehicles may be operated in the paved/gravel areas of the paddock.
13. Pit and pre-grid roads must remain clear. This is a fire department requirement.
14. Speed limit in paddock is **SLOW!!** Please use extreme caution. The race chairman will strictly enforce this regulation.
