It is now the season for offering constructive suggestions for improving ICSCC. If you have ideas to share, please let me know and we will take a serious look at them.

Drivers, this is your final reminder that Contest Board Reps are beginning to hold rules change meetings. Right now you have a chance to submit and vote on proposals that could revise or add new rules to the Competition Regulations. I hope you take the time to attend your club's meeting.

It's also the time of year to be thinking about Driver of the Year nominations. Each member club, affiliate club or licensed driver may submit nominations for 'Driver of the Year' to the Race Steward. Nominations must be submitted in writing no later than September 16, 2007. The selection committee consisting of Race Steward Ron Muro, last year's recipient Craig Curtis and the Competition Committee (see pg. 132 of the rulebook) will meet on September 29th at Pacific Raceways after the Novice races to select the 2007 recipient. **The criteria for selection are sportsmanship (on and off the track), driving ability, and contributions to ICSCC.**

Finally- at the risk of sounding like a broken record, and having all of you ignore me, I'd like to mention volunteers. Volunteers are the lifeblood of our organization. We cannot exist or operate without them. As we've recently seen, they can make a huge difference in our lives. And we need more. Whether you can contribute a little or a lot, to your club or ICSCC, your help is important to us. Please consider getting involved and recruit your family, friends (or even strangers) to come have FUN with ICSCC.

So . . . is anyone interested in serving as Assistant Steward next year? We will need another dynamic duo to keep you all in line. It's Ron and Hal – 2007. Who will step up and be Hal's other half in 2008? Think about it, ask questions, and if it's right for you let us know.

Next stop, Mission. See you at the races.

I.R.D.C. EVENT SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS

1. Open to cars eligible under I.C.S.C.C. and S.C.C.A. current regulations.
2. There will be no starting of any race engines prior to 9:00 a.m.
3. No class changes after 1:00 p.m. on Saturday.
4. Drivers are responsible for properly and completely filling out their entry registration form(s).
5. Multiple Entries: A driver entering the same car in more than one event shall indicate on each entry form whether the entry is for the driver's "primary" or "additional" event. If the entries are oversubscribed for a particular event (entries exceed the number of cars allowed on the track) drivers and cars entered as an "additional" event will be restricted from participating, on a first come, first served priority based on the date the entries are received, in order to allow participation by all drivers and cars for whom the event is their primary event including novices upgrading to a championship event on that week-end.
6. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is NOT allowed at any time during the racing event, except in the area covered by the liquor permit issued by the Washington State Liquor Control Board. The time and location is a condition of operation of the track and is enforced by track officials, ICSCC, and IRDC officials or law enforcement authorities.
7. All Entrants shall present at tech inspection empty, seal-able, container(s) marked with driver's name and car number, capable of holding 2 gallons of liquids. These are to be used to remove all oil, cleaners, brake fluid, etc. from P.R. Anyone caught dumping oil at the raceway will be fined and banned from Pacific Raceway. There will be a \$10.00 per tire charge imposed by the track for the disposal of tires.
8. Damage to the track, grounds or buildings, regardless of cause, will be charged to the driver responsible. Any damage to any equipment or devices utilized by the sanctioning body (ICSCC) or sponsoring club (IRDC) to conduct this race, regardless of cause, will be charged to the driver responsible.
9. NOISE RULE I.C.S.C.C. 1112 enforced! 103db @ 50 ft. No exceptions.
10. All persons in pre-grid or in racing hot pits shall wear long pants, shirts that cover their shoulders and no open-toed shoes during all practices, qualifying and races.
11. A Minor Release form is required for ALL minors upon entry to the track (NO EXCEPTIONS). Minors must be under direct supervision of an adult at all times. No minors under 18 years of age are allowed in the hot pits or pre-grid. Operation of any type of wheeled transportation (bikes, scooters, motorcycles, skateboards, skates, etc.) is forbidden for anyone under the age of 16 years.
12. All cars will be off trailers for tech inspection.
13. There will be no refunds on prepaid pit passes.
14. Driver must appear in person at registration to add a crew-member to the list on their registration form.
15. All participants are required to have and display at all times the appropriate pit, crew, guest, or worker pass issued for this event. Passes are required for reentry to Pacific Raceway during this event.
16. No overnight camping at the track on Sunday night without the consent of P.R. management.
17. There will be no refueling in the grid area unless accompanied by a fire extinguisher and operator.
18. No motorized tow or support vehicles allowed on pre-grid unless authorized by the Grid Marshall or Race Chairman. Support vehicles behind pre-grid must be parked along the fence
19. No open fires are allowed in the paddock, pre-grid or within the track in-field.
20. All gates are locked at 11:00 PM Friday and Saturday nights. The main gate will open at 7:00 AM.
21. Only one support vehicle or trailer is allowed in the pits per competition car.
22. There will be no saving of pit or paddock areas except as required by I.C.S.C.C. regulations with exception of Novice License director or by Race Chairman for cause. All other pit and paddock areas are on a first come, first served basis. Violators of this regulation can be subject to disqualification.
23. The length of scheduled events may be altered by the Race Chairman due to emergency conditions beyond the control of I.R.D.C. personnel.
24. I.R.D.C. reserves the right to refuse entry to this event to anyone.
25. Line formation to enter the track on Friday afternoon shall start at the main registration booth. The waiver sheet must be signed prior to entry into the pits on Friday.
26. No bicycles, scooters, or walking allowed on the access road adjacent to the main straight from the paddock to pre-grid. This is a P.R. rule.
27. Pets must be leashed at all times and owners are responsible for cleaning up animal waste.
28. All in-car timing system transmitter beacons will be placed at a marked location as defined by the Race Chairman. All transmitters outside of the specified area will be confiscated and retained by the Race Chairman.
29. Turn 1 / Pit Out blend line violators will be dealt with by the Race Steward.

In Memoriam

NORM HERNANDEZ, 1941-2007

On Saturday, July 14, the Conference community lost a respected competitor and good friend when Norm Hernandez was killed in the crash of his aircraft. Reflecting the thoughts of many, Trout Roberts posted on the ICSCC forum a few days later, saying "I'll miss my friend, Norm... my thoughts and prayers are with his family and those who were close to him. He was instrumental in the success of Formula Mazda in the Pacific Northwest. I'll continue to look for him in my mirrors."

Also posted on the Conference forum was the following message from Norm's family:

Dear friends, family and colleagues,

As many of you know by now, my father, Norm Hernandez, was killed in a plane crash this past weekend.

On Saturday July 14th, Norm was flying his Yakilov 55 aerobatic plane to Paine field from Arlington when he encountered engine trouble and was forced to search for a place to land. Neighbors reported hearing his engine cut in and out, and seeing the plane crash into a backyard, where it burst into flames. Medical examiners report that he died instantly and did not suffer.

Based on my conversations with eye-witnesses as well as with the NTSB, it is clear to all of us that Norm's last efforts in life were to insure that he did not harm anyone else as his plane fell from the sky. Having met the 10 and 11 year old girls who lived in the house he flew over just before the crash, I can say that his efforts were not in vain. I will never ever forget those little girls' faces, nor how their mother failed to contain her emotion over what she described as my father's "heroics".

Norm was a husband, father, son, grandfather, pilot, racecar driver, hunter, fisherman, sailor, engineer, mathematician, MIT Alumnus, PhD, UW professor, mechanic, horseman, houndsman, entrepreneur, leader, and one hell of a good shot. I was never once able to beat him at the shooting range! Norm's absence will be felt strongly in family and local business circles, but it will be felt equally in the worlds of racing, sailing, and flying. And while I wish I had my father back more than anything in the world, I am to some small extent able to find comfort in the fact that he lived a full life and died doing something he loved: flying.

Now, let's move on to some "good things"... I am sure that there are other racing sanctions in which the drivers would love to be able to create their own rules. Well you have that privilege, so be sure to participate in your club's rule change meetings. It is your right and duty to promote your very own racing democracy. So please, get out of the garage, and go vote at your club meetings!

Also, we are beginning to think about who will be our Driver of the Year this season. Think about it... talk about it... then let your Competition Committee representative know who you want to nominate. Your representative's name and address are located on page 132 of your ICSCC Rule Book. Nomination must be done in writing, and include the reasons for your nomination.

The criteria are: sportsmanship (on and off the track), driving ability, and their contributions to Conference Racing. It would be best to leave out things like: "My nominee calls out 'HERE' on my behalf when I miss a Drivers' Meeting", or "So and so is the best 'bump drafter' in my group". Got it? Good! So let's get going and get your nominations in to a Competition Committee member, ASAP. Later on, I will probably use your list of nominees to portray the "good guys" in my forthcoming book... Now, whom could I get to be the villains? Any ideas?

Fresh squeezed by the ICSCC License Director

Wear white to learn and have fun!

Pick up just about any "Learn to Race" book and you'll find it extols the virtues of working corners. The corner station provides a unique viewpoint to study the track terrain and its effects on various cars and drivers. A seasoned racer strives to shave tenths of a second off his or her lap time. In a complex turn like 3A/3B at Pacific Raceways there is often 5 seconds difference between identical cars from braking to exit, and there is no better observation point than the turn station at 3A. Not yet convinced? Spend some time with the turn workers and benefit from their willingness to share driving insights gleaned from years of experience. Many of these safety officials have race history themselves and know all too well the dynamics of the track.

Flip through any book on teaching and somewhere you will read that people learn best by doing. Once you have jumped the wall toward a hot track to aid a driver, you appreciate fear the workers feel as racers are speeding by. These racers – secure in their harness and surrounded by a safety cage – are sure they are in complete control and not likely to endanger the car in trouble or the worker. The worker, however, is not in a cage, has just seen one car go off track, and is torn between assisting the driver in trouble and staying alive. Know what it is to be a safety official and you learn to better respect their job.

How many of your friends and family have said they would love to race if they could afford it? Racing is expensive. Volunteering is free. The thrill of racing can be felt on both sides of the wall. Turn officials have the best seats in the house! They are in communication with race central so they know what is going on all around the course, and they are on the front line when something happens at their station.

Racing ICSCC provides an environment for camaraderie. Safety officials have as much or more fun than the racers. They don't have to work on their cars, change tires, add gas, or worry about missing a track call. Still, the stresses of weather, track conditions, and disparate driver skills can be draining, and these stalwart volunteers generally unwind with gusto at the end of the day.

Never take turn workers for granted. Express your appreciation for their role in keeping us all safe. Even better, consider

- working turns to learn about track dynamics and your fellow racers
- coming to races you can't enter and volunteering as a safety official
- encouraging your friends and family to join the safety crew

Respect and enjoy the conscientious, fun loving community on the other side of the wall! And always remember... unless there are qualified safety people in place, there is no race for the rest of us.
