President's Message

Okay, it's official! We have a 2008 race schedule! You can find the complete list of events printed in this Memo and posted on the web.

This season's offerings will include 15 driver trainings, 2 enduros, and 13 championship races (including 2 double races). For the first time in a long while, there are no back-to-back weekends on the schedule. Please note that **Race #13** has been listed as **tentative** for the second year in a row. The construction schedule at Oregon Raceway Park is still uncertain; further information regarding the status of this race will be reported no later than June 1st.

For those who haven't heard, both Portland and Mission will have different track layouts this year. Large investments of time and money have been made to improve the 'old' tracks. I hope you will include them on your race schedule. They should add some new challenges and FUN to our season. And remember, there will be new track records set in every class – will one of them belong to you?

In the last Memo, I introduced you to some new ICSCC Officials for 2008, including Race Steward **Hal Hilton**. And it came as no surprise when **Mike Blaszcak** was approved as Assistant Steward at the Spring Meeting. What you may not know is that **Jeff Penick** was also approved as an additional Assistant Steward. All three will be working together on race weekends to make sure the ICSCC rules and regulations are properly enforced. That means three sets of eyes watching your every move! It might be worth spending a little of your winter break

dusting off your rulebook and reviewing the rules of the road. You'll definitely want to be on your best behavior at the track this season.

Another new official this year is **Bob Mearns**. Bob (2007 points proofer and PRO-3 driver) replaces B. ekiM as your 2008 Points Keeper. Thanks, Bob!

Two more changes to report for 2008: an updated and improved entry form, and online registration. Club registrars Debbie Morton (IRDC) and Holly Remington (CSCC) have been spearheading these projects. The objective is to improve the racing experience for both drivers and registration workers. At each race, drivers will be required to submit information on the new entry form (please throw out any old forms; they will not be accepted at registration this year).

Also at the Spring Meeting, the E-Board voted to amend the rulebook and PPM to allow clubs the option of developing an online registration system. While the details are still being worked out, Cascade is hoping to give it a try at their first race in April.

That's all for now. Coming soon: RATS meeting - February 23rd (Best Western PepperTree, Auburn).

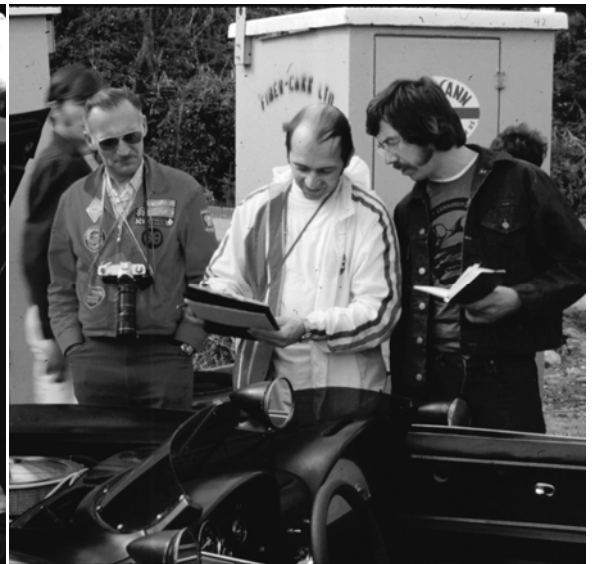

Steward's Soapbox

Some Quick Thoughts

This season will fortunately see the addition of a second Assistant Steward. I am grateful to our Conference E-board for approving the position at the Spring Meeting. After working together with Ron this last season, it became obvious that the responsibilities of the Race Stewards on any given race weekend are extremely time and energy consuming. Thus having one additional person to properly assist in administering those responsibilities was greatly needed.

Driver safety, conduct and rule adherence is of the utmost importance for the wellbeing of Conference in general and for the individual driver in specific. During my tenure as Race Steward this year, I want to pay special attention to the safety standards of our racing equipment, along with the correct installation of that equipment.

For example, many of you now wear a head and neck support system and have made the changes to your helmets making sure it is was installed correctly. Many installers do a fantastic job of doing this right along with making sure you are informed about all of the features. However, have you also made the changes to your seat back to make sure you have adequate room to facilitate your device? And do you have your shoulder straps correctly mounted on the support bar behind your seat at the recommended distance, angle and spacing?

Issues such as this, along with several others are what the Race Stewards are going to be looking at this year in our attempt to help you be a much safer driver. Having the second assistant available to work closely together with you in finding ways to make your car more reliable and safe is in my opinion, invaluable!

So, as we get closer to getting the 2008 season under way, take some time to look closely at your car and your equipment to make certain it is in good mechanical order and installed according to both the rulebook and the manufacturers recommendations. Doing so now just might make the difference in how you exit your car after a potential (heaven forbid) accident.

Well, are you ready for some racing? I know I certainly am! IRDC's 3rd Annual 4-Hours of Pacific Raceways will be right around the corner when you read this column. And I hope you have been working hard either to have your car ready to compete, to be ready to co-drive with another team, or you're ready to lend a hand as a highly valued volunteer. Either way, I'm excited to get the season started and am looking forward to seeing everyone again!

Pre-Season Race Preparation

Race season is just around the corner. If you think in weekend days, the first event is only ten days away. Scary, isn't it?

Like any good plan, you need to set some goals and prioritize them. All of these goals will involve one or more of the following: driver, car, time, or money.

Driver...

- Get your license application and physical completed and sent in to Karen McCoy, ICSCC License Registrar.
- Get your body in shape.
- Get your mind in shape.
- Set personal goals with measurable benchmarks for success.

Car...

If you rent –

- Determine how much time and money you have available.
- Find a car or cars to rent.
- Submit a proposal to the owner(s).
- Draft and sign your 2008 contracts.

If you own -

- Make sure the car is safe.
- To increase reliability, replace questionable parts and improve instrumentation.
- Clean up your work area. Inventory to ensure consumable parts are on hand or on order.
- Clean, inspect and tighten all components.
- List the performance options you would like and determine their impact on your time and dollar budgets. If these options mean forfeiting a race weekend, are they really worth it? **Remember, the best item to improve in any race car is always the driver.**

Time and dollar budgets are items you have to work out as best you can. The race schedule is now published so you can decide what works best for you. If dollars are shorter than time, consider coming out to the track and spending time with your friends as a volunteer. You can learn as much by watching from a turn station as you do behind the wheel.
