I like to think of Conference as providing a product to its customers. The product is safe, enjoyable, and competitive racing. The customers are drivers, and even some spectators, too. If we have truly safe and fun competition, then we've got a great product - and we'll attract more customers. Interestingly, the customers are, in a way, the product themselves. But we need a critical mass to make the product interesting. If only a few customers are showing up, then the product isn't interesting to more customers.

Some clubs have reputations concerning safety and competitiveness. Either because of too much contact, too much dangerous driving, troublesome volunteers (including bad stewards!), or a problematic rule set, the reputation of these clubs falls off, and customers go away.

Early in my driving career, I attended a lapping day sponsored by some two-bit fly-by-night organization. As their customer-- $\$ 350$ for the whole day, if I remember correctly - I drove my Porsche at Pacific Raceways. Their flaggers didn't speak English and had no training. They didn't have a standby ambulance. When one car rolled, other drivers stopped on track under a standing yellow flag to rock it back onto its wheels.

Despite my lack of experience, I thought this was just insane and didn't feel safe. I wanted the track time to work on my chops, but I certainly didn't need the time that badly!

On the other hand, the incredible camaraderie in the PRO3 ranks is a great example of the Conference product. The fierce competition in the SM grids is exemplary, too. The AS guys have great fun at every race, and are happy to drive with you even if you're not in their class. The Legends guys are having a hoot and a half at every race!

Given this unique definition of "customer", I view providing an excellent customer experience as my primary duty to Conference. Obviously, safety is of the utmost concern. Our volunteers deliver on the promise of making drivers feel safe; no matter where you go wrong on track, help is only a radio away and a highly-qualified worker is at your window in seconds.

I do whatever I can to help them, and I also have to make sure competition doesn't get out of control. I help the workers by writing penalties that remind drivers to check for yellow flags. I'm hoping that a slap on the wrist will have a driver remembering to check turn stations at each corner before making a pass or racing to the incident. For some drivers, a more substantial penalty might need to be offered as a reminder.

While I know that cars will occasionally collide, I prefer to see clean, safe racing. Drivers who earn a reputation for unpredictable or overly aggressive driving are on my radar, and I use the rulebook to remind them that they need to be sportsmen.

## Steward's Soapbox continued...

The rule book offers me three levels of response to contact incidents.

One is to rule that the incident is just "racing contact". I don't like this choice because it means that nobody was at fault. Somebody probably was, but the contact wasn't malicious, doesn't represent bad driving or careless racing habits, and both competitors acknowledge that. Racing certainly isn't rubbing, but two cars competing for position might touch incidentally--and hopefully inconsequentially.

If the evidence I have makes me believe that a penalty is necessary, l'll write a fine for "avoidable contact". (CR 1517.A) I like to use this when there's no malicious intent, but the result of the contact is more severe than "racing contact" would imply. The message l'd like a driver to take away from this kind of incident is that their contact was avoidable, and though it wasn't unusual for the sport of auto racing, more care should be taken to assure it doesn't happen often. We're just club racers; we're not out to bill sponsors for everything we can on the way to a national championship.

Past "avoidable contact" is "dangerous driving". (CR 1517) I will write this penalty in situations where I think the driver has made a bad decision on the track with an outcome that should have been foreseeable. For example, "banzai" breaking, purposefully punting another driver, or trying to execute a move when the car was obviously not on line and in shape to take the chance are all situations where this penalty is warranted.

Trying to push a barely-controlled car past a competitor is a prime example of "dangerous driving": If you're just a little off line, your car is squared up, and you've got a clear view, go for it. If you screwedup the entry, bobbled the apex, and are trying to make a move around a corner where you can't see the exit because you're so off line and sloppy, you should collect your car and take a run at it in the next corner.

A driver who's done something plain stupid, or repeatedly breaks the rules, is a driver that's not part of the Conference product. (CR 402.B.3) A driver that does not care about making them self look bad by repeatedly threatening the workers or other drivers, repeatedly wrecking their cars, or not improving when their bad habits are brought to their attention
is a driver that should find another venue for their hobby. Or, should find another hobby altogether!

It sounds like l've described a lot of whipping sticks. But where are the carrots? They're in the rule book, too. Each club chooses a Driver of The Year, as does Conference itself. (P\&P 12.3.2) We award Championship Points that accrue at each race towards a season-long champion for each class. (CR 503) Champions don't lose points by getting disqualified for bad passes; Drivers of The Year don't wad-up cars by making ill-advised moves on track.

I've added my own incentive this year, as well. For each race group, each weekend, that comes back in with no actionable reports, I'm donating ten dollars to the Doernbecher Children's Hospital. This isn't much, though it'll add up over the summer. Do you really want to be the driver who causes a report to be written that prevents me from putting a sawbuck into the kitty for the kids?

## CSCC Supplemental Regulations 2009

## Infractions will result in penalties assessed to the driver.

1. Open to cars eligible under ICSCC current regulations.
2. This event is organized under 2009 ICSCC Competition Regulations, and all who enter PIR are subject to them. Cascade Sports Car Club reserves the right to refuse entry to this event or to PIR at any time.
3. Alcoholic beverages allowed in the beer garden area only, and only after the track closes. You may NOT bring alcohol into PIR! This is an Oregon Liquor Commission requirement. Any person caught entering PIR with alcohol will be removed from the raceway.
4. Registration Hours: 6:00 pm-8:00 Friday, 7:30 am-12:30 pm Saturday and 7:30 am - 10:00 Sunday
5. Express Tech is available at Registration for those drivers who meet the following: 1. Fully completed their entry form prior to Registration. 2. Prepaid in full. 3. Present to Registration with no license issues. 4. Vehicle has a transponder, and do not require a rental. 5. Have an acceptable Annual Tech inspection noted in their vehicle logbook. 6. Not part of the mandatory Tech presentation group for the weekend. At registration, Express Tech drivers should bring their personal safety gear and vehicle logbook to Registration where your gear will be inspected and a weekend tech sticker issued. Express Tech eligibility is decided by the Registrar. Express Tech hours: 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Friday and may be available 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. Saturday
6. People under 18 years old are not allowed in hot pits, pre-grid or on victory laps. Children under 12 must have direct adult supervision at all times.
7. A current and properly completed minor release form, signed by an authorized adult, must be on record for all minor participants brought into PIR.
8. Competition numbers must be readable: Section 1106 enforced.
9. The scales will be open Saturday from noon and Sunday all day.
10. No skateboards or scooters allowed in the paddock area. Users of bicycles and small-motorized vehicles may have riding privileges revoked at any time by the Race Chairperson.
11. Refueling not allowed in pre-grid. Fueling in the hot pits requires a crewmember assigned only to operate a fire bottle. Excess spillage will result in a penalty.
12. No smoking allowed in hot pits, pre-grid or any PIR building.
13. Only one support vehicle allowed in paddock. Pit and pre-grid roads must remain clear.
14. Noise rule ICSCC 1112 enforced! 103 dB at 50 ft .: no exceptions!
15. Oregon State Law requires functioning mufflers to be used at PIR. Functioning mufflers must be capable of reducing sound energy by at least 5dB at trackside. Cars losing mufflers, even if they are still below the sound level, will be blackflagged immediately.
16. Damage to the track, grounds or buildings, regardless of cause, will be charged to the driver responsible. Also, damage to any equipment or devices used by the sanctioning body (ICSCC) or sponsoring club (CSCC) to conduct this race, regardless of cause, will be charged to the driver responsible.
17. Family and crewmembers of drivers are to contact the landline communication person at pre-grid with any questions regarding their driver or car while on track.
18. All entrants for this event shall present at tech inspection an empty, sealable container or containers, marked with the driver's name and license number, capable of holding 2 gallons of liquid. These are to be used to remove all oil, cleaners, brake fluid, etc. from PIR. There will be no drums provided.
19. Anyone caught dumping oil at the raceway will be fined and banned from the raceway. This is a PIR regulation.
20. If entries exceed the number of cars allowed on the track for a particular event, drivers and cars entered as an "additional event" will be restricted from participating, on a first-come, first-served priority based on the date entries were received. This is in order to allow participation by all drivers for whom the event is their primary event, including Novices upgrading to a championship event.
21. NSF checks will be charged an additional $\$ 50$ fee.
22. The racing "hot pit" is defined as that area under the control of Hot Pits personnel. This area is located immediately west of the break in the concrete wall half way up the pit lane. Per ICSCC rule \#1607, any person over that "pit wall" during practice, qualifying or races shall wear long pants, shirts that cover the shoulders, and shall not be barefoot or wear opentoed shoes. At the one-minute warning, pre-grid becomes a "hot" area. At that time, pre-grid must be cleared of all crew, support personnel and spectators. Notwithstanding the above, ICSCC rule \#1607 does not apply to the pre-grid area.
23. All cars that are towed into the paddock area are subject to being dropped off in impound.
24. The 5 -minute warning will be given approximately 8 minutes before the scheduled race time
25. Due to recent incidents, extension cord from the pit exit to tech/scales, must use a more secure method other than Duct Tape
26. Staggered start and split start requests shall be submitted to the race steward no later than the end of on-track activity on the day previous to the race.

# Orange-Aid <br> Fresh squeezed by the ICGCC License Director 

The race weekend at Mission was interesting for me, and for others I suspect. In both of my race groups, the weather changed, while I was sitting in the car on pregrid, from dry to rain sprinkles. My first thoughts were of the concrete walls lining the circuit, the general smaller size of the circuit and the number of cars in the group, the hp under my foot and slicks under my personal g-meter, and how interesting this was going to be. I usually try to find some lesson or take-away from every session I have on track, and wondered what it was going to be this time. I was hoping that it wasn't going to be that I should have stayed parked in the paddock.

A wet circuit evokes many different emotional reactions, from simple curiosity, to a mild (or not so mild) anxiety, or maybe just outright terror. This emotional state probably depends upon the type of car you're racing, the size of the race group you're in and your confidence in those drivers, the characteristics of the circuit, and a long list of other things. One of the things that may affect this emotional state could be your confidence in the race car in wet conditions. "They" say that the true measure of a race car driver is racing in the rain. Whatever.

Many people feel that a race car chassis needs a completely different set of adjustments for a wet circuit. This is probably true for those of us that have even a minimum amount of reasoning ability, which isn't me. It's also a completely different matter to have the ability to do a complete package when you have the luck to know the weather far enough out, which is almost never the case. Usually it's a situation of making some hasty decisions and last minute changes in the paddock as the weather changes somewhat quickly. Things like disconnecting the sway bars, softening the shock valving, changing the brake bias, tire pressures, and other things.

Speaking for myself, since I'm not too smart, I have to apply the KISS principle. I have had some unique experience that has proven this principle to be valid too. In the past, I ran circle track at Monroe, (I know...) and Monroe is the only place in the world as far as I know that runs roundy-round races rain or shine. I guess that's what has to be done when you have a track where it rains a lot.

Running race cars with slicks in the rain, on an oval where the entire surface closely resembles T8 at Pacific Raceways, is quite an interesting experience. It's basically more slippery than ice. Competitors and crew chiefs tried all kinds of whacky chassis adjustments and tire pressures in an unsuccessful attempt to find some grip, any grip. There simply wasn't any. One of the more interesting strategies was running very low tire pressures.

It was almost comical to watch the tires on some cars flopping all over the place.

I finally concluded that it is better to just leave the car alone. Don't change anything, except maybe raise the starting tire pressures to compensate for less pressure build up from heat, and then just drive what you're used to. Otherwise, I couldn't figure out if the car handled poorly because of surface conditions, line selection, or the changes. Was it the chassis, the tires, my driving, or what? Trying a "leave it alone" approach in wet conditions, I found that the car would react and handle in a familiar and predictable way, maybe more slowly or with less precision, but predictably. Then I could eliminate that question mark from my mental checklist, and concentrate on searching for grip on the track by trying different lines. That was my lesson from that experience.

Since then, I have had the opportunity to run in several road racing sprint races and enduros, some in the wet, in many different types of cars. One enduro event in particular comes to mind, where the conditions before the race looked like rain, and there was a good discussion about what changes, if any, should be made to the car to compensate for the conditions. As part of a team, I had the opportunity to express my opinion that we leave the car alone except for starting the tires pressures a few pounds higher. After some fairly intense discussion, this strategy was accepted for better or worse, and we started the race with no chassis changes from the normal dry setup except the slightly higher starting tire pressures. From our starting position several rows down in the order, in a matter of a lap or two we were in the lead of the race. We held the lead, in front of many more powerful cars, for almost two hours into the race, until just before our fuel stop. Our finish was second place overall. It sure seemed that the KISS principle was validated that day.

Fast forward to sitting in the car in the pre-grid area in Mission, as the rain drops began to accumulate on the windshield. I thought about what changes to the car I would have made if I had the chance. After considering things for a few minutes, I couldn't really think of anything that would have made a difference. After the fact, I sure had some ideas, like installing a fan for some defrosting action, but at the time nothing really came to mind. I figured it would simply be a matter of adapting shift points, maybe using a higher gear in places for less engine speed and torque, and trying some different lines. The race went really well for me, and I don't have any complaints beyond not being able to see very well, which is what you get in a car that's basically a sieve with hot headers turning water to steam.

## Orange-Aid continued...

I evolved to these wet weather strategies, and learned the value of the KISS principle over the years, after racing the types of fully fabricated race cars where there are so many possible adjustments that it's extremely easy to screw things up. With these types of cars especially, there is a $99 \%$ rule. This means that whatever change you make, there is a $1 \%$ chance it will make the car better, and a $99 \%$ chance it will make things worse. A production based race car won't be quite as sensitive, but there is still a better chance than not that any given adjustment will prove to affect things in ways that are difficult to predict.

These are simply some thoughts about what has worked for me, based on my limited experience. Please don't take them to be a gospel. I don't pretend to know what works for everybody, and as always, "your results may vary"...

See you in Spokane, where if things go as usual, the conditions couldn't be much more different from the last race.

Your application/entry to the event constitutes acceptance of these Supplementary Regulations. Infractions will result in penalties being assessed to the driver.

1. All events are to be held on the Mission Raceway Park road course in a counter clockwise direction.
2. All events will be timed \& scored by the AMB Transponder System. Race cars must have a suitable transponder installed and operating in each session.
3. Open to cars eligible under ASN Canada FIA, CACC, SCCA or ICSCC current regulations.
4. Insurance shall be as per ASN Canada FIA and CACC regulations or ICSCC as applicable.
5. All competitors, entrants, crewmembers and guests must sign the official release agreement and waiver.
6. All minors (under 19) require a signed "minor waiver" for each event (available at Registration).
7. Minors (16 and over) are allowed to be in hot pits provided a parent/legal guardian has signed the appropriate minor waiver.
8. NSF cheques will be charged an additional $\$ 40.00$ Canadian fee.
9. Competitors affected by a race cancellation will be notified by telephone, if possible, or by first class letter.
10. Consumption of alcohol during an event is NOT PERMITTED at Mission Raceway Park! You are responsible for the behavior of your crew and guests.
11. Registration \& Tech hours and procedures for handling Late Entries as per the race announcement.
12. Driver Services and the Official Notice Board are located in the SCCBC Clubhouse near Pregrid.
13. Novice/License Director will be located just west of the entrance to pit lane.(ICSCC-Pit 1)
14. No racing engines may be started prior to 8:50am. Warm as quietly as possible until 9:00am.
15. The scales will be open Saturday from noon and Sunday all day.
16. No skateboards, scooters, or roller blades. Bicycles and small motorized vehicles allowed by permission of the Race Chairmen only. Permission may be withdrawn at any time. NO ONE UNDER 16 IS ALLOWED TO OPERATE A MOTORIZED VEHICLE!
17. Both front paved lanes in the Paddock area run EASTBOUND after 8:50am. Rear lane is two way. Speed Limit: SLOW - excessive speed will be subject to penalties assessed by the Race Chairmen.
18. Refueling not allowed in Pregrid. Fueling in the Hot Pits requires a crewmember assigned only to manning a fire bottle.
19. NO SMOKING allowed in Hot Pits, Pregrid, or any Mission Raceway Park Building.
20. The Hot Pit speed limit is Fifty (50) Kilometers per hour ( 30 mph ). The Hot Pit Lane ends at the Starters Tower.
21. Only ONE support vehicle allowed in Paddock/Pit area. Roads MUST remain clear. All Support vehicles and trailers must be parked perpendicular to the track unless permission is obtained in writing from the organizer.
22. No race vehicle may exceed 95decibels (db) measured at 50 ft . from the racing surface. Readings will be taken at an acceleration point Cars exceeding the db limit will have one or more of their Qualifying times in that session erased, or be disqualified from their race.
23. Damage to track, grounds, buildings or equipment, regardless of cause, will be charged to the driver responsible. Damage to paved areas may result in fines. You are required to protect the asphalt from damage by jacks, jack stands, poles, etc.
24. If entries exceed the number of cars allowed on the track (determined by the Race Chairmen) for a particular group, drivers and cars entered, as an "additional entry" will be restricted from participating, based on the date the entries were received. This is in order to allow participation by those for whom the event is their primary event, including novices upgrading to a championship event.
25. All entries for this event shall present, at tech inspection, empty sealable container(s) marked with the driver's name and number, capable of holding 8L. (2 US gal.) of liquids. These are to be used to hold all oil, cleaners, brake fluid, etc. There are recycling containers for these fluids along the back road of the paddock near the garbage cans.
26. All hazardous waste spills are to be reported to the Race Chairman. Anyone caught dumping oil will be FINED and BANNED from the raceway. There are recycling containers for these fluids along the back road of the paddock near the garbage cans.
27. DO NOT BLOCK THE PAVED PADDOCK LANES DURING RACES. Trailers may be loaded at the back of the paddock.
28. Tire scrubbing is not allowed at any time during practice or qualifying sessions. Scrubbing is allowed only on the pace laps preceding the initial green flag starting a race, or under pace car control.
29. The importation and use of leaded fuels for use in motor vehicles is permitted in Canada only for use in racing vehicles. Leaded fuel is not available for sale at gas stations in Canada.
30. No open fires anywhere! Barbecues will be the only exception as long as they are away from any combustible source such as gas cans, gas tanks or fuel cells, etc.
31. No overnight camping at the track Sunday night without permission, please contact the SCCBC President.
32. Gates are closed for the evening at 10:30pm and reopened at 7:00am. In case of emergency please call the emergency access number posted on the inside of the front gate. There is a pay phone at the far east end of the spectator parking lot.
33. Long pants, sleeved shirts, closed toe shoes, and visible wristbands are to be worn in the Pregrid, Hot Pits and Impound areas.
34. Cars arriving at Pregrid after the 5 -minute warning will be put at the back of the grid
35. All pets must be on a reasonable length leash while on site.
36. Late Registrations on Sunday MAY be accepted, at the Race Chairmen's discretion.
37. Upon exiting the hot pit, stay in the dedicated pit-out lane to turn 1. Failure to comply may result in penalty or exclusion
38. All race participants and their race/support vehicles must vacate the premises by 7 PM on the final day of each event.
39. Any race vehicle on the run off road drivers right turn four must come to a stop prior to Turn Station 6 and wait for direction from a Corner Worker prior to re-entering the track. No positional advancement or lap time advancement will be allowed. Failure to comply may result in a penalty.
40. Race cars failing to negotiate Turn 1 may not re-enter at Turn 3. Position your vehicle until eye contact is possible with Turn 1 station and re-enter at Turn 1 as directed when safe to do so. Failure to comply may result in penalty or exclusion.
41. The 5 -minute warning will be given no earlier than 8 minutes before the scheduled race start.
42. Any race vehicle that exits the racing surface in 7A or 7B must re-enter the track only when safe to do so. . No positional advancement or lap time advancement will be allowed. Failure to comply may result in a penalty.
43. Vehicles exiting the track via the pit entrance must stay four wheels to the right of the white pit entrance line in Turn 9 for the entire length of the white line. Failure to comply may result in a penalty.
44. Vehicles not exiting the track must not place four wheels to the right of the white pit entrance line in Turn 9. Failure to comply may result in a penalty.
45. Staggered start and split start requests shall be submitted to the race steward no later than the end of on-track activity on the day previous to the race.
46. The SCCBC reserves the right to, at their discretion, refuse entry and/or access and/or remove participants from the Mission Raceway Park.
