President's Message

A troubling incident has come to light in the world of motorsports. It is allegations of possible impairment of non-spectators at race tracks. The issue is being investigated by headquarters and although there is no proof that any individual has been impaired while participating in our events there are some items of concern uncovered during this investigation. Specifically these allegations revolve around substance abuse and the use of inhalants. Some may not be seeing this practice as illegal due to the products being sold legally for other purposes; however their usage results in impairment, and that contravenes our rules while at any of our events. ICSCC Competition regulation #610 refers to impairment and how we are to handle suspected occurrences. Section 6 of the ICSCC rule book is entitled "Entrants and Drivers" and may have been interpreted by some to mean only competitors and their teams. **NOT SO!!** This section refers to all participants at a Conference event. Changes to clarify Section 6 have been approved by the e-board and are included in this Memo.

It is expected that people will conduct themselves as they wish while away from our events, however once we enter the property of any ICSCC event we are expected to be in compliance with all our regulations (ref ICSCC comp. Reg. 108).

Should anyone not feel 100% ready in the morning for what ever reason, please take the

time to fully recover before heading to the track, or sit out some time as a spectator until you are completely fit. ICSCC is comfortable leaving interpretations of intoxication or impairment to state and provincial authorities. What we all must do is watch out for each others safety and enjoyment while we participate in our events. To that end ICSCC will promote a drug free environment encouraging a zero tolerance for all forms of intoxicants. The success of this program depends on each of us taking the responsibility for ensuring our safety both individually and collectively. We must not tolerate those few individuals who put us at risk. They should remove themselves from the property and rethink their commitment to our sport and our participants. We must all take the responsibility to ensure every participant at our events is capable of operating at the high level of concentration and physical ability a race track demands.

Please take the time to familiarize yourself with our rule book no matter how or where you participate in our events.

ICSCC Mid-Season Rule Change

104. ICSCC reserves the right, in an emergency, to make and implement emergency rulings and decisions which it deems necessary in order to properly conduct sanctioned races and events, and voluntary participation of any competitor in the race event constitutes that competitors recognition and acknowledgement of the absolute emergency powers of ICSCC.

The above rule authorizes the e-board to implement mid-season rule changes they feel will benefit the ICSCC. The e-board met at PIR Aug 14, to discuss items of concern with regards to the interpretation of our existing Section 6 of the 2010 ICSCC Competition Regulations. The rule has been amended as follows and will be enforced immediately. Along with this rule change the ICSCC will be promoting a drug free environment at all ICSCC events.

SECTION 6 – ALL PARTICIPANTS, ENTRANTS and DRIVERS

601. A) Definition of entry. An entry shall consist of a combination of a car and driver. Any change of car or driver after entries close shall be considered as a late entry. Any change during an event must have the Race Steward's approval.

B) Definition of participant. A participant is any person having access to any official area requiring a pass to gain entry.

610. Impairment. Note: This rule will be strictly enforced. ~~Breathalyzer~~ Testing may be utilized.

Any person who has consumed alcoholic beverages, inhalants or drugs so that he/she is still affected on any day of the race must be examined by the Course Physician. If the Course Physician judges the individual impaired he/she shall refer the matter to the Race Steward. Participation in any capacity in this event will not be allowed, nor will the individual be allowed in official areas. Official areas are defined as those requiring a pass to gain entry. Day of the race is defined as from sunup to the completion of the final race of the day. Any further action will be at the discretion of the Race Steward and the Executive Board.

Steward's Soapbox

As this is written, the season is moving into the home stretch with three races remaining. It's a good time to begin to reflect on this year and start thinking about 2011. We are fresh off race number 11 at PIR, conducted in oppressive heat but with a good turnout and spirited racing. This race was hosted jointly by CSCC and SCCBC and our Canadian friends showed up in good numbers. Thanks to all who made the long trip, made even longer by having to slog through Seattle area traffic coming and going.

Race number 10, conducted by IRDC at Pacific Raceways, deserves special mention not only for having a huge turnout but also for being one of the cleanest weekends in recent memory. With 274 entries and several grids of over 50 cars, there was a potential for mayhem. Instead, the weekend went smoothly and on schedule and most significantly, without a single penalty written against a driver. Reflect on that for a minute. I'm sure there have been other weekends in the past with no penalties, but for that to be the case in midseason with several championships still on the line and car counts like this is a true testimonial to our drivers. Ladies and gentlemen, I tip my hat to each and every one of you. I have never been more proud of our drivers. It was a true display of Conference racing at its best. It is also worth mentioning that we had seventeen SCCA licensed drivers join us, including almost ten who entered the German Car Challenge. It was a treat to have them on our grids and I hope they come back often.

Looking back on the season, we have had relatively good turnouts, especially considering the economy. That seems to reflect the very good value that our drivers perceive for their Conference racing dollar. We also saw Oregon Raceway Park come on line, and so far the drivers seem to have a very favorable impression of the track and the races that have been held there. In addition, we attempted something new, which was to conduct two races on a two-day weekend at Mission. Although the schedule was tight, the drivers seemed to appreciate the value this format provided.

Looking ahead to the post season, the rules change process is under way and proposed rules changes will be published in Memo # 8. By the time you read this you should have had your chance to propose changes through your individual clubs. This process is one of the remarkable aspects of Conference and we should remember how special it is in amateur racing worldwide.

Moving on to some nuts and bolts of race craft, this month we want to talk a bit about an area that seems to cause some confusion among our drivers. Specifically, in a passing situation, when must the car being overtaken alter its line to make room for the overtaking car? A few

years ago a previous Steward decided that we needed something more definitive to determine a driver's responsibility in this situation. The Conference rulebook language dictates that both drivers have a responsibility for leaving racing room on the track surface in any case where two cars attempt to share the track. That can happen in the brake zone for a given corner, approaching the apex of that corner and on the exit of the corner. The current interpretation for determining racing room says that once an overtaking car establishes its nose abeam the overtaken driver's door, or shoulder in the case of purpose built cars, the driver being overtaken must allow room on the track surface for the overtaking car. If this occurs in a braking zone before a driver has made a steering input for the apex, it is relatively easy to deal with. This is especially true when the overtaking car has superior performance or grip compared to the car being overtaken. It gets more difficult, however, when a pass is attempted involving two cars of nearly identical performance. The "nose abeam the driver's door" rule makes sense when you realize that most drivers, once they have made a steering input toward the apex, have their eyes up and looking ahead to the apex and beyond. It isn't realistic to expect that driver to look in his/her side mirror for a car with a six-inch overlap and adjust his/her line to make room. Also, this interpretation prevents an overtaking driver from executing a late braking banzai move to stick a nose in, hoping the car ahead will flinch and go wide. That kind of "pass by intimidation" gets a very cool reception from your current Steward team.

It should be pointed out that passing and sharing the track can create a large number of scenarios, most of which can't be spelled out in detail here or in the rule book. When in doubt, leave room for one another but at the same time, if you intend to pass a competitor in a corner you need to present yourself according to the previously mentioned policy or you can expect to have the door shut on you and if contact occurs, you might find yourself on the receiving end of a penalty.

As always, if you have any questions about this or any other aspect of our rule book, please contact one of the Stewards either by phone or at track. Speaking of that, we will see you all at the Doernbecher Dash in September.

At the ICSCC Fall Meeting, there will be a "Code of Conduct" presented and brought up for discussion. This is being brought about, as the above 4 simple words, seem to need reinforcing.

ICSCC, as with many many businesses and industries, will be striving to be a drug-free zone. There will be those that disagree with this, but the ramifications of ICSCC not being pro-active on this are great.

"Safety First" does not just apply to fire bottles and tow trucks. It applies to us all.
