STEWARD'S SOAP BOX

It's time for another Steward's Corner and as I am writing this we have two championship races in the books. If you check out the penalty box you will see we have had only a couple but way below par, which all golfers know is a very good thing. I'm updating this at the completion of Race 2 (BBQtoU at the Ridge) because it is as close to hole in one (keeping with the golf analogies) as I have seen. Lots of great racing and only two incident reports (one of those in Novice) and NO penalties!!!!! I told my brother flag as a first warning, a third incident will result -in-law that I wasn't sure it was possible to have a "fun" weekend being steward, well you guys just proved that wrong. It was a great weekend. Keep up the good work!

The Ridge made do with bare minimum of experienced workers. I hope we don't have to cut it that close again. Thanks to all who participated and thanks to the drivers (and crew) that stepped up. All of us drivers should consider working one race each year to help ensure we can continue to enjoy our passion.

Speaking of passions, OK pet peeves, I would like to talk about spins and offs. I'm not talking about contact induced incidents, I'm talking about loss of control incidents. Rule 1506 states "A spin-out is defined as constituting rotation of the car in excess of 90 degrees to the

direction of the circuit, and/or becoming stationary, and/or four wheels off course. Four spinouts... shall automatically bring disqualification (black flag), providing the driver is deemed solely responsible." Four offs/spins in a single session seems like a very out of control driver and therefore dangerous to himself and others. Consequently, while a DQ will result after 4, we are not waiting until then to react. A driver with two offs and/or spins will receive a furled black in an open black flag and a discussion with one of the stewards and then a DQ after a subsequent incident.

This policy seems well accepted and noncontroversial, so I would like to have you think about a scenario that came to mind based on brief exchange with a driver at race #1. I asked him how the weekend went and he proudly stated only one off and (now the gotcha) one off per session should be OK, right? Can you guess what I responded? How would you respond? I will be asking for your response at a future driver's meeting.

Welcome to Drivers Spotlight 2014! Flying Bye Photo is proud to present this new and great idea for 2014! We hope you enjoy learning more and more about the drivers you race with door to door during ICSCC Race weekends! The way this works is every month, I take one driver and interview them, asking them questions about their motorsports background as well as their car! Hope you enjoy it!

James Colborn is a very experienced driver who has raced at the amateur level as well as the professional level racing in the IMSA Continental Tire Challenge Series. Racing is a huge passion of James's and he enjoys improving himself off the track by analyzing the data he collects from the track! He is one of the top drivers in the extremely competitive PRO3 class. Even though he hasn't been able to win a PRO3 Championship, he is one of the fastest and most experienced racers out there, and I'm sure in the next few years he is a candidate to take home the ICSCC PRO3 Championship. He's starting his 5th year in Conference racing and is very excited to get out on track. Now here are some questions we asked James, about him and his car........

FB- How did you get in to sportscar racing?

[JAMES] - I was lapping my street car (a Cayman S at the time) with ProFormance Racing School when Don Kitch Jr. threw me the keys of their rental PRO3 car and said "have a go in that". It's been a slippery slope since then as I loved it. Even though I was 10 seconds off the pace the first time I drove a PRO3 car, with the help of Ken and Wes Hill, I ended up racing in PRO3 in ICSCC.

FB- What inspired you to want to race a PRO3 BMW 325i?

[JAMES] - Initially it [PRO3] was the chosen path for graduates from ProFormance Racing School. I was also attracted to the car count in each race weekend hoping it would provide me with more of a racing challenge. I was right, it provided great racing, however, now I'd say it's those factors plus the group itself is one of the most communal and friendly collection of amazing people I've ever known.

FB-What is the most memorable race you have ever had?

[JAMES] - The PRO3 NASCAR support race(s) in 2012. I'd qualified on the front row but on the start I tried to out brake Ryan Hieronymus into T1 at PIR and we both over shot the corner. We were then held at the exit of the chicane until all of the other 42 entrants into the race passed and we were dead last. In the space of the following 40 mins I passed 30+ cars to finish the qualifying race in 9th which allowed me to go into the Sunday race in 9th which I converted into 3rd place.

FB-What's it like racing at the professional level?

[JAMES] - Exciting, hard, humbling and intense. You have far less time to get up to speed, all of the other drivers are as good as the top 10% to 20% of any car class in the US and the racing is close, aggressive

FB-What do you like and enjoy about ICSCC racing?

[JAMES] - Everything! I love the group, the friendship, the variety of racers, the feeling of belonging to something that is so much greater than the individual parts. My particular favorite is/are the regular volunteers and workers who make the weekends so special. From the sense of calm they bring to a nerve filled pre-grid to the overwhelming comfort brought by the diligent corner workers and safety crew.

FB-What's your favorite car in the world?

[JAMES] - 1965 Mini Cooper S.

FB-What's your favorite part of being a PRO3 driver?

[JAMES] - PRO3 is very special to me. My PRO3 car is like a friend, my fellow PRO3 drivers like family and racing PRO3 is like the best entertainment and challenge that never gets old. I've made some of the best friends in PRO3 and it has personally given me the stepping stone to new and exciting racing challenges.

FB-What's the history and background of your PRO3 Car?

[JAMES] - PRO3 #7 was built but never raced by a guy who moved to California and had to sell it. It was a relatively basic PRO3 when I bought it and I raced it as was for the first couple of years (2010 and 2011) without any improvements. In 2012 I installed a few upgrades (new shocks and diff) and in 2013 I gave it a new fancy paint job and this year I'm putting a few more new parts on it. CSCC Supplemental Regulations 2014

Infractions will result in penalties assessed to the driver.

- Open to cars eligible under ICSCC current regulations.
- This event is organized under 2014 ICSCC Competition Regulations, and all who enter PIR are subject to them. Cascade Sports Car Club reserves the right to refuse entry to this event or to PIR at any time.
- Alcoholic beverages allowed in the beer garden area only, and only after the track closes. You may NOT bring alcohol into PIR!
 This is an Oregon Liquor Commission requirement. Any person caught entering PIR with alcohol will be removed from the raceway.
- 4. Registration Hours: 6:00 pm-8:00 Friday, 7:30 am 1:30 pm Saturday and 7:30 am 10:30 am Sunday.
- 5. Express Tech is available at Registration for those drivers who have an acceptable, current Annual Tech inspection noted in their vehicle logbook, and the driver is not part of the mandatory Tech presentation group for the weekend. Express Tech drivers should bring their personal safety gear and vehicle logbook to Registration where your gear will be inspected and a weekend tech sticker issued.
- People under 18 years old are not allowed in hot pits, pre-grid or on victory laps. Children under 12 must have direct adult supervision at all times.
- A current and properly completed minor release form, signed by an authorized adult, must be on record for all minor participants brought into PIR.
- 8. Competition numbers must be readable: Section 1106 enforced.
- 9. The scales will be open Saturday from noon and Sunday all day.
- 10. No skateboards or scooters allowed in the paddock area. Users of bicycles and small-motorized vehicles may have riding privileges revoked at any time by the Race Chairperson.
- Refueling is not allowed in pre-grid. Fueling in the hot pits requires a crewmember assigned only to operate a fire bottle. Excess spillage will result in a penalty.
- 12. No smoking allowed in hot pits, pre-grid or any PIR building.
- 13. Only one support vehicle allowed in the paddock. Pit and pre-grid roads must remain clear.
- 14. Noise rule ICSCC 1112 enforced! 103.0 dB at 50 ft.: no exceptions!
- 15. Oregon State Law requires functioning mufflers to be used at PIR. Functioning mufflers must be capable of reducing sound energy by at least 5dB at trackside. Cars losing mufflers, even if they are still below the sound level, will be black-flagged immediately.
- 16. Damage to the track, grounds or buildings, regardless of cause, will be charged to the driver responsible. Also, damage to any equipment or devices used by the sanctioning body (ICSCC) or sponsoring club (CSCC) to conduct this race, regardless of cause, will be charged to the driver responsible.
- 17. Family and crewmembers of drivers are to contact the landline communication person at pre-grid with any questions regarding their driver or car while on track.
- 18. All entrants for this event shall present at tech inspection an empty, sealable container or containers, marked with the driver's name and license number, capable of holding 2 gallons of liquid. These are to be used to remove all oil, cleaners, brake fluid, etc. from PIR. There will be no drums provided.
- 19. Anyone caught dumping oil at the raceway will be fined and banned from the raceway. This is a PIR regulation.
- 20. If entries exceed the number of cars allowed on the track for a particular event, drivers and cars entered as an "additional event" will be restricted from participating, on a first-come, first-served priority based on the date entries were received. This is in order to allow participation by all drivers for whom the event is their primary event, including Novices upgrading to a championship event.
- 21. NSF checks will be charged an additional \$50 fee.
- 22. The racing "hot pit" is defined as that area under the control of Hot Pits personnel. This area is located immediately west of the break in the concrete wall half way up the pit lane. Per ICSCC rule #1607, any person over that "pit wall" during practice, qualifying or races shall wear long pants, shirts that cover the shoulders, and shall not be barefoot or wear open-toed shoes. At the one-minute warning, pre-grid becomes a "hot" area. At that time, pre-grid must be cleared of all crew, support personnel and spectators. Notwithstanding the above, ICSCC rule #1607 does not apply to the pre-grid area.
- 23. All cars that are towed into the paddock area are subject to being dropped off in impound. Drivers must wear all required drivers safety equipment (per ICSCC rule # 1105) before they are allowed to enter the track, while they are on the track, beyond positive protection, under flat tow, or in the hot pits area.
- The 5-minute warning will be given approximately 8 minutes before the start of the race.
- 25. Due to recent incidents, extension cords from the pit exit to tech/scales must use a more secure method other than Duct Tape.
- 26. Staggered start and split start requests shall be submitted to the race steward no later than the end of on-track activity on the day previous to the race.
- 27. Blendline- the Red Blendline stays on drivers left as you enter the racetrack from the pit area. You are required to stay on the right side until the Red Blend line ends. This is <u>REQUIRED EVERY TIME you</u> enter the Race Track, other than the race out lap. The Red Blendline stays on the drivers left at the end of the Turn 12 tirewall. <u>If you are to exit the race track at anytime, you are required to stay completely to the right.</u> If you cross the blendline with ONE TIRE you are required to stay out for one more lap unless you are exiting the track after you have received the checkered flag and crossed the start/finish line.
