FROM THE PRESIDENT

OW, time for another Memo article. By the time you read this, IRDC's Spring Enduro will likely be history or very close to history and only a couple more weeks until the first championship race at PIR on 5/6 & 7. I'm struggling this year; 5/6 is one of the THREE days of our local Halibut season this year so The wind will probably blow, I'm going racing. I hope it doesn't rain or I will be wishing I went Halibut fishing. Besides the normal race fun (competition and friends), I am excited to attend CSCC's 5/6 race because they are trying something new; they combined groups 3 & 6 so they could have a HPDE/Advanced School group. This was something that came up in a conversation I had with Armadillo Andy last year as a possible way to get non-racers to the track on race day, hopefully enticing them to think about getting into racing. Please be sure to be extra friendly to the HPDE folks. We have done another rule clean-up with respect to minor bicycle riders. Our Insurance Advisor, Dave Bennitt, determined our current rule was overly restrictive and so we lowered the age to 12 years or older. The actual rule reads:

1603. C. Children under twelve years of age may remain in the paddock area only under the direct, active and continuing supervision of an adult. No bicycles are allowed in the racing pit area except as they may be used by Race Officials. Bicycles may be operated in the paddock area by persons over 16 years of age 12 years of age and older, unless restricted by the race sponsoring club in supplemental regulations for the event. Dogs are permitted in the paddock area

only if they are leashed with a leash of six feet or less in length. The leash must at all times be held by an adult (over 18 years of age and older) or be attached firmly to an immovable object such as a car or trailer. Dogs are absolutely prohibited from entering the pits. Dog owners are solely responsible for the sanitary condition of the paddock area and those not picking up after their pets will be subject to a Fifty Dollar Fine.

The strike-out is what was deleted and the underlined is the new text.

I shouldn't admit this but the section of the rule about how old one has to be to walk a dog surprised me and is probably a surprise to some of you. Most folks I know think their dogs are family and have no problem letting their children walk their dogs. I had neighbors who let their 4th grader walk their Great Dane. I have seen a terrier that was on a leash attack a much larger dog. So I guess I understand the rule. The person walking the dog needs to be capable legally of controlling the dog and be capable legally of being responsible for whatever happens.

Now to get my parts ordered and car prep'd (I did get my license renewed, so if you haven't done that, you better be extra nice to the registrar). I upgraded the axles on my trailer so hopefully no more breakdowns beside the road to fix a wheel bearing.

All drivers 18 years old and over with a valid unrestricted competition license issued by ICSCC, SCCA, CACC, FIA, ASN, or NASA. Other licenses may be approved by the ICSCC License Director.

FRIDAY TEST AND TUNE:

Race car test and tune event, rotating groups. Novice license holders authorized by the ICSCC License Director are welcome. Paddock entry restricted to participants, officials and volunteers until 4pm.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION:

Entries with a 2017 Annual Tech sticker on your logbook can complete your race tech form at registration and receive your weekend tech sticker then and there and be good to go. Drivers without 2017 Annuals must have your car and apparel inspected by an authorized tech official. Tech officials will be roaming Friday evening, or bring your car and gear to the scale station area for inspection.

International Race Drivers Club Supplemental Regulations - Pacific Raceways

- 1. The event is open to race cars meeting current year ICSCC competition regulations.
- 2. The event is organized according to current year ICSCC competition regulations. All persons entering the event and/or Pacific Raceways property are subject to current year ICSCC competition regulations.
- 3. All persons entering Pacific Raceways property must sign in on the event waiver document at the main gate and wear the provided wristband at all times. An additional minor release form is required for all persons under 18 years old. IRDC reserves the right to refuse entry to any person for any reason without explanation.
- 4. Minors under the age of 12 must be under the direct supervision of a responsible adult at all times. All Minors are not permitted at any time in any "hot" area.
- 5. Persons under 12 years old may not use any kind of wheeled transportation on Pacific Raceways property, including but not limited to bicycles, scooters, motorcycles, skateboards, skates, etc...
- 6. The paddock area entrance road gates may be locked between the hours of 11:00 pm and 7:00 am.
- 7. There is no parking permitted along the paddock entrance road, or along the fence line at the north edge of the paddock. This is a defined fire lane, any vehicles parked there will be immediately towed with no notice.
- 8. 5 mph speed limit in the paddock.
- 9. Pets are welcome, but must be leashed at all times and under the control of someone 18 years of age or older. Please clean up after your animal.
- 10. One support vehicle or trailer per race car in the paddock.
- 11. Authorized vehicles only on the race course at any time. No motorized vehicles of any kind permitted at any time on the race course without permission or authorization from ICSCC officials.
- 12. No race car engines running before 9:00 am or after 7:00 pm. Quiet hours are from 10:00 pm to 7:00 am. Please respect and be considerate of the neighbors to preserve our future ability to hold events at Pacific Raceways.
- 13. ICSCC event noise rule 1112 is in effect at all times. 103.0 dB @ 50 feet. No exceptions.
- 14. Positively no dumping of oil or other hazardous substances on Pacific Raceways property. Anyone doing so will be charged with all mitigation costs, could possibly be criminally charged, and will absolutely be permanently banned from all IRDC events.
- 15. Any damage to Pacific Raceways property and or facilities, including but not limited to the track, barriers, fencing, buildings, etc..., regardless of cause, whether accidental or intentional, will be billed to the responsible person. Likewise any damage to equipment or devices provided by ICSCC or IRDC regardless of cause will also be billed to the responsible person.
- 16. No open fires permitted.
- 17. Race car traffic only on the pre-grid access road adjacent to the front straight. No street cars, pedestrians, bicycles,
- 18. No motorized tow or support vehicles are permitted on pre-grid, unless specifically authorized in advance by the Grid Marshall or Race Chairman. Please park support vehicles behind the pre-grid area along the fence line.
- 19. The "5 minute warning" on pre-grid will be given at approximately 9 minutes prior to the actual race start time.
- 20. No refueling on the grid without a dedicated person at the ready with a suitable fire extinguisher.
- 21. The Turn 1 blend line is in effect. Violations are subject to penalty.
- 22. Should you happen to use the turn 3A escape road, you are required to stop completely at the end of the escape road where it re-joins the circuit and wait until released safely into traffic by the turn station officials at turn 4. There will be a minimum 10 second hold to adjust for the time gained by shortcutting the circuit, but the wait may be longer until a safe opening in traffic occurs, which will be at the sole discretion of the turn station official.
- 23. The race schedule may be altered by the Race Chairman due to emergency conditions.
- 24. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted at any time during the racing event, and governed by permit conditions during the times when racing events are concluded.
- 25. No race class changes after 1:00 pm on Saturday afternoon.
- 26. The authorized location for timing beacons/devices is in the gated area east of the walkway to the turn 9 grandstands. No other locations are permitted, timing equipment placed outside of the authorized area will be confiscated.
- 27. Requests for split or staggered starts for championship points events must be submitted to the Race Steward by 5:00 pm Saturday.
- 28. Overnight camping on Pacific Raceways property Sunday night requires permission from track management.


