

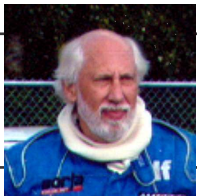

### FROM THE PRESIDENT

Hello again,

**Y**es, I shirked my duties last month and didn't produce a President's Message for the last Memo. Well this month I have official duties to attend to, so...

The Steward's Corner was pretty lengthy in the last memo so you may have missed that there was an active appeal of the Steward's penalty assessment against Glenn Nixon, Car 77 for Dangerous Driving. The Conference procedure for appeals of the Steward's decisions is published in Section 10 of our Competition Regulations. Following the procedure Dave Dunning (our Steward) prepared a packet consisting of his rationale, memos from both parties involved in the incident and 3 in car videos and distributed the packet to our nine Contest Board members. The Contest Board is basically the jury of your peers when it comes to appeals and there is one Contest Board member from each of the 5 Member Clubs and one from each of the 4 Associate Member Clubs. (we actually have 5 Associate member clubs, but Sovren had not yet notified me of their representative).

The Contest Board members then have up to 20 days to vote to affirm or deny the Steward's decision. The members send their votes to me (as President) and I am obligated to publish each of the Contest Board Members vote.

All nine of the Contest Board members voted unanimously to affirm the Steward's decision which included a \$100 fine, a 3 race suspension, and loss of a lap. Dave felt this penalty was appropriate because he could not be 100% certain of Glenn's motives.

Having been on a jury for a murder trial, I learned we can rarely be 100% certain, so I used a lesser criteria of "certainty beyond a reasonable doubt". After talking with Dave, a past steward that was in the stands watching, another driver that had interaction with Glenn on Saturday and with Glenn, I concluded there was some threatening behavior by Glenn Nixon on Saturday after group 2 of race 7. After reviewing the 3 in car videos, I also concluded the incident during group 2 of race 8 was easily avoidable on Glenn's part. Therefore using the authority granted to me as ICSCC president in Section 3.1.2.4 of our Policy and Procedures, I increased the penalty assessed against Glenn Nixon to suspension from racing in an ICSCC sanctioned event through 2019 and a 6 race probationary period starting in 2020. If there is any penalty for contact during the probationary period then subsequent suspensions will be invoked.

Since Presidential disciplinary actions can be appealed to the Executive Board where a simple majority determines the outcome, I checked with the Executive Board and made sure they would stand behind this action. While not unanimous, it was more than a simple majority.

We as a racing community cannot tolerate threatening behavior on or off the track. Racing is inherently dangerous. I want to be able to trust that my fellow racers have my best interest at heart just as I do for them.

Only two more championship races to go in the 2018 season, Saturday and Sunday Sept 15 & 16 at the Ridge. Hope to see you there.

## STEWARD'S CORNER

Hello Conference Folks,

**A**t the time I write this, there are two more Conference racing events; a double championship race, Thunder on the Ridge on September 15, 16 and the Festival of Endurance at Portland International Raceway on September 29. I hope to see many of you at both places. I hope the season ends with fantastic races and does not end on a bang (as in bending body parts).

I mention a few rules below that quite a few of us may have forgotten and/or choose to ignore. This is my not-so-subtle request to follow the rules to avoid discussions with the volunteer officials (workers). When there is ambiguity, they will always call the stewards Scott and me, and no one seems to like that.

Rule 406 D: "Cars that suffer significant damage will have it noted in their log book by the Chief of Tech or his/her assistant." Significant damage is judged by the Chief of Tech. Please let them do their job.

Rule 712: "Retirement. A car which exits the race course and enters the paddock area during a race shall be considered to have withdrawn from the race and may not re-enter the race course."

Rule 714: "Failure of finishers designated by the Race Steward to report directly to the scales at the end of their race will result in disqualification." Here, "directly" means do not go to the paddock first and/or do not hide put a crew member in your trunk and then go to scales. Also: "Any car required to weigh at the end of a race that does not meet the required minimum weight, will be disqualified."

Rule 911: "Course impound. Each competitor in Conference Championship events shall remain at the race course with his/her automobile for a minimum of one hour after his/her race or may leave only with special permission of the Race Steward."

Rule 1105, E, 4: "Drivers shall be required to wear a Nomex type hood or helmet skirting." Wear a balaclava. Please.

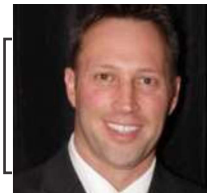
Rule 1106, A: "All numbers and class designations must be in sharp contrast with the background."

Rule 1106, L: "Any car without weight race stickers that attends scales must present their log book with correct and current weight information." Also: "It is the responsibility of each competitor for the accuracy of his/her minimum race weight(s)."

Rule 1111: "The Race Steward(s) shall issue and fill out the vehicle description section of all ICSCC vehicle log books." and Rule 1111 A. "Vehicle owners may be issued a vehicle log book, which shall remain with the car." Do not twist the use of "may" in the previous sentence. Each competing car must have a log book and it must be in the car when you are competing.

In summary, I am honored to be trusted as the conference steward. The best summary of what I am striving for is rule 402, C, 1: "He [the steward] shall be the guardian of observance of the Competition Regulations and of just treatment between Officials and competitors." Thank you reading and helping me and Scott out.

## ENDURO CORNER

**O**nly two weekends remain in the Northwest Mini Enduro Championship Series (NWMECS) for 2018. The next race is September 15<sup>th</sup> at The Ridge with the series wrapping up in Portland two weeks later on September 29<sup>th</sup>. The two-hour Portland finale counts as two races but single points.

There are a couple of tight points battles going on. In MSR there is a tie at the top between Grimsrud and Owens. In ME0 Levine leads by just six points over Duske while in ME1 Northrop has a ten point lead over George. Hovington has an eleven point lead over Ecker and McAffer in ME2 with Tobey commanding a fifteen point lead in ME3. With two (technically three) races remaining, no one has sown up the title of champion in any of the five classes.

The season ending Cascade enduro is Saturday, September 29<sup>th</sup>. This event traditionally marks the end of the ICSCC race season. As mentioned in previous articles there are a few changes to this year's event. The major changes are an earlier date, a chicane event, and the race will be run in all daylight. What stays the same is the format – 2,4, and 8 hour races. The class format and general rule set are also unchanged and so is the early entry and tow discounts that were offered last year. September 10<sup>th</sup> is the deadline for the discounts so enter soon!

It's shaping up to be a busy September so plan on getting in some racing as the off season in the northwest is plenty long!

## International Race Drivers Club Supplemental Regulations– The Ridge

1. The event is open to race cars meeting current year ICSCC competition regulations.
2. The event is organized according to current year ICSCC competition regulations. All persons entering the event and/or TRMS property are subject to current year ICSCC competition regulations.
3. All persons entering TRMS property must sign in on the event waiver document at the main gate and wear the provided wristband at all times. An additional minor release form is required for all persons under 18 years old. IRDC reserves the right to refuse entry to any person for any reason without explanation.
4. Minors must be under the direct supervision of a responsible adult at all times. Minors are not permitted at any time in any “hot” area.
5. Persons under 12 years old may not use any kind of wheeled transportation on TRMS property, including but not limited to bicycles, scooters, motorcycles, skateboards, skates, etc...
6. The paddock area entrance road gates may be locked between the hours of 11:00 pm and 7:00am.
7. There is no parking permitted along the paddock entrance road, or along the fence line at the north edge of the paddock. This is a defined fire lane, any vehicles parked there will be immediately towed with no notice.
8. 5 mph speed limit in the paddock.
9. Pets are welcome but must be leashed at all times and please clean up after your animal.
10. One support vehicle **OR** trailer per race car in the paddock.
11. Authorized vehicles only on the race course at any time. No motorized vehicles of any kind permitted at any time on the race course without permission or authorization from ICSCC officials.
12. No race car engines running before 8:00am or after 7:00 pm. Quiet hours are from 10:00 pm to 7:00 am. Please respect and be considerate of the neighbors to preserve our future ability to hold events at TRMS.
13. ICSCC event noise rule 1112 is in effect at all times. 103.0 dB @ 50 feet. No exceptions.
14. Positively no dumping of oil or other hazardous substances on TRMS property. Anyone doing so will be charged with all mitigation costs, could possibly be criminally charged, and will absolutely be permanently banned from all IRDC events.
15. Any damage to TRMS property and or facilities, including but not limited to the track, barriers, fencing, buildings, etc..., regardless of cause, whether accidental or intentional, will be billed to the responsible person. Likewise, any damage to equipment or devices provided by ICSCC or IRDC regardless of cause will also be billed to the responsible person.
16. No open fires permitted.
17. Race car traffic only on the pre-grid access road adjacent to the front straight. No street cars, pedestrians, bicycles, etc...
18. No motorized tow or support vehicles are permitted on pre-grid, unless specifically authorized in advance by the Grid Marshall or Race Chairman. Please park support vehicles behind the pre-grid area along the fence line.
19. No refueling on the grid without a dedicated person at the ready with a suitable fire extinguisher.
20. Pit Exit blend line is in effect. Violations are subject to penalty.
21. The race schedule may be altered by the Race Chairman due to emergency conditions.
22. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted at any time during the racing event, and governed by permit conditions during the times when racing events are concluded.
23. No race class changes after 1:00 pm on Saturday afternoon.
24. The authorized location for timing beacons/devices is in the gated area east of the walkway to the turn 9 grandstands. No other locations are permitted; timing equipment placed outside of the authorized area will be confiscated.
25. Requests for split or staggered starts for championship points events must be submitted to the Race Steward by 5:00 pm Saturday.
26. Overnight camping on TRMS property Sunday night requires permission from track management.
27. TRMS will not be providing power to drivers or crew. You will need to provide your own power if needed.

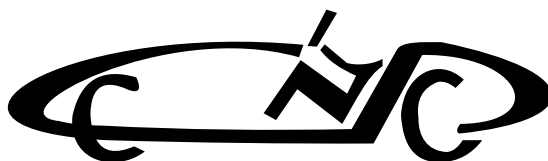

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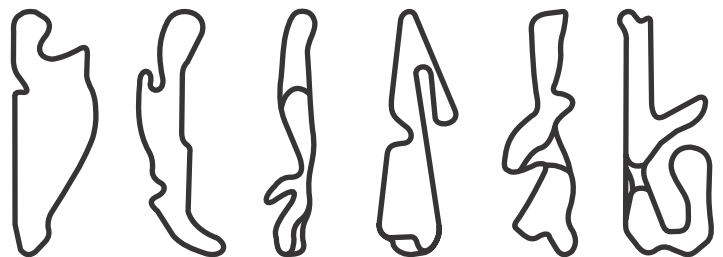


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
