FROM THE LICENSE DIRECTOR

ooking forward to the 2022 season, one can be hopeful that the open borders, relaxing social restrictions, and the retreat of the pandemic will bring out the cars and the people once again. Including a new host of Novice and Observation drivers ready to join the Senior license racers. There does seem to be a lot of interest reaching me so far, which I hope bodes well for the season and Conference.

As most are aware, due to the dwindling car counts and increasing track time costs, the Group 7 race group has been eliminated from the race weekend schedule. On the current schedule, Cascade has committed a dedicated G7 practice and qualifying group to the Opener. That should give everyone a little breathing room as we warm our heads back up into the season. The Novice drivers will still get placed in the Senior run groups for the Championship races. They will again be gridded at the back of the field regardless of qualifying times. diagnosed a problem with my rental car, and came over and fixed it with me. 


