Proper format for a rule change proposal:

Instructions for submitting rule change proposals:

- 1. Explanations of the rule change proposals will **not** be published.
- 2. Leave 'Yes' and 'No' blank. This information will be added once the vote has taken place.
- 3. Type or print in block capitals. Unclear proposals cannot be promulgated.
- 4. You are required to provide the page number that the rule is currently published on, taken from the complete ICSCC Competition Regulations.
- 5. Provide the club (initials sufficient) that is submitting the rule change proposal.
- 6. Provide the Section (rule number) in its entirely, as well as its jurisdiction (E, C or E/C).
- 7. When adding words or sentences, underline all wording to be added: new wording appears thus.
- 8. When deleting words or sentences, strike through (using a single straight line) all wording to be deleted: wording to be deleted appears thus.

Rule change proposals are called for by August 1 by the clubs' Contest Board representatives, who bring them to their club for voting, and then present those endorsed by the club to the Race Steward. If you have any questions about the process, first read Section 1A of the Competition Regulations, then consult the Race Steward or Assistant Race Steward.

Although explanations of proposals are not published with the proposals themselves, discussion is encouraged, so that drivers will understand the intent of the rule change as well as all possible effects and implications, before it is time to vote. The ICSCC Drivers' Meeting forum has a board dedicated to rule change discussion for exactly this purpose: it is found online at **www.icscc.com/discus**.
